Step 1: Clear your Firearm - Check the Chamber, Bolt Face and Magazine Well.

Step 2: Gather Parts and Tools needed for Installation.





Step 3: Make sure your Bolt is Locked Back. Pull forward on the Latch on the Underside of the Barrel. Rotate the Barrel 45 Degrees Towards you and Pull it off.





Step 4: Unscrew and Remove the Thread Protector.







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Step 5: Get your Barrel Clamped in your Vice Jaws so you can Freely Access the Muzzle.



Step 6: Use your Wire Brush to Clean the Threads of the Barrel.





Step 7: Put a Dab or Two of Rocksett on the Threads.



Step 8: Slide the Raised end of the Crush Washer onto the Barrel.







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Step 9: Thread the Muzzle Brake onto the Barrel.





Step 10: Tear off a Piece of Masking Tape. Wrap it around the Muzzle Brake Four Times and Compress it down.





Step 11: Use your 13/16 or Adjustable Wrench to Start Tightening the Brake. To Fully Crush the Crush Washer, Rotate it 540 Degrees. When you feel it start to Bind, back off your Wrench a Hair and Reposition.





Step 12: When you have about 90 Degrees Left, Fully Back off the Wrench to Relieve some Tension. Then Tighten The Brake the Final 90 Degrees.








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Step 13: If you have a Level, Use it to make sure the Barrel is Level in the Vice. Then Place the Level on the Brake to Check if it's Level.





Step 14: Remove the Masking Tape from the Muzzle Brake.





Step 15: If you have CLP Handy, use some on a Rag to Clean the Tape Residue off of the Muzzle Brake.





Step 16: Check that the Brake is Level one more time, Then Remove the Barrel from the Vice.





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Step 17: Lock the Bolt Back on the Receiver.



Step 18: Stick your Barrel into the Receiver. Rotate it Towards you, Insert it the rest of the way, and Rotate it back to Lock it.





Step 19: That's it! You're All Set!
